

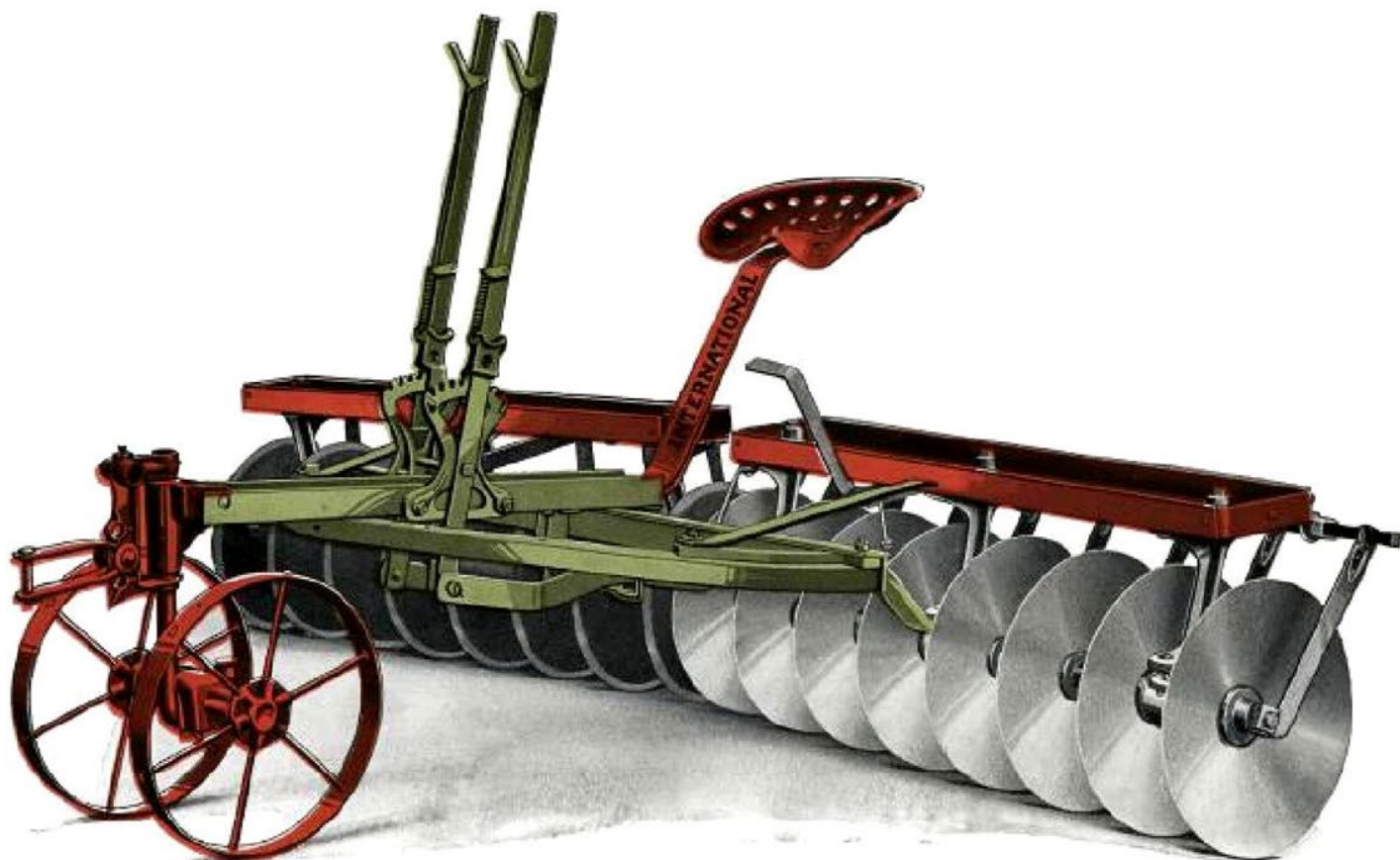
Illust. 1—International threshers put the grain into the sack instead of the stack. Made in two sizes, 22x38 and 28x46.

Illust. 1—The Titan 10-20 is equipped with all the features essential to a practical farm tractor. It does belt and drawbar work equally well.



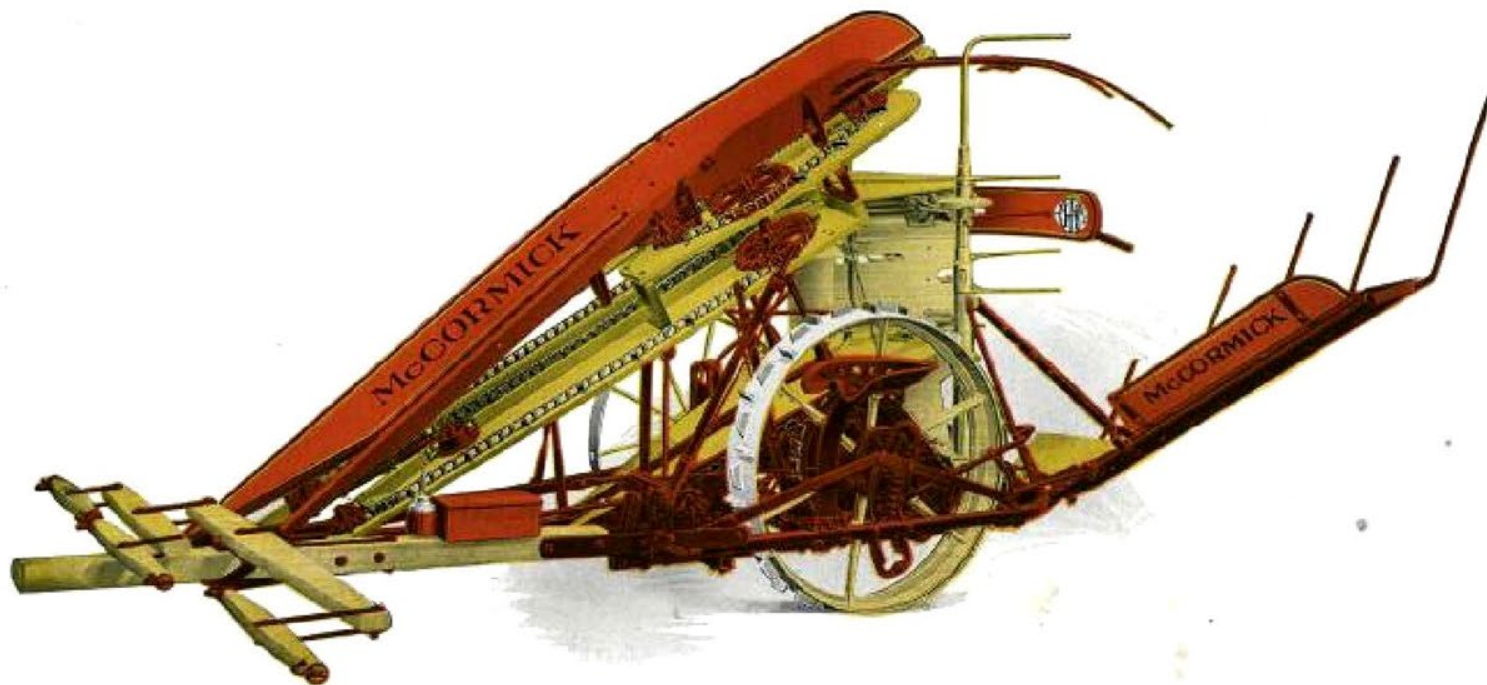
Illust. 1—International 8-foot disk harrow, equipped with forecarriage.



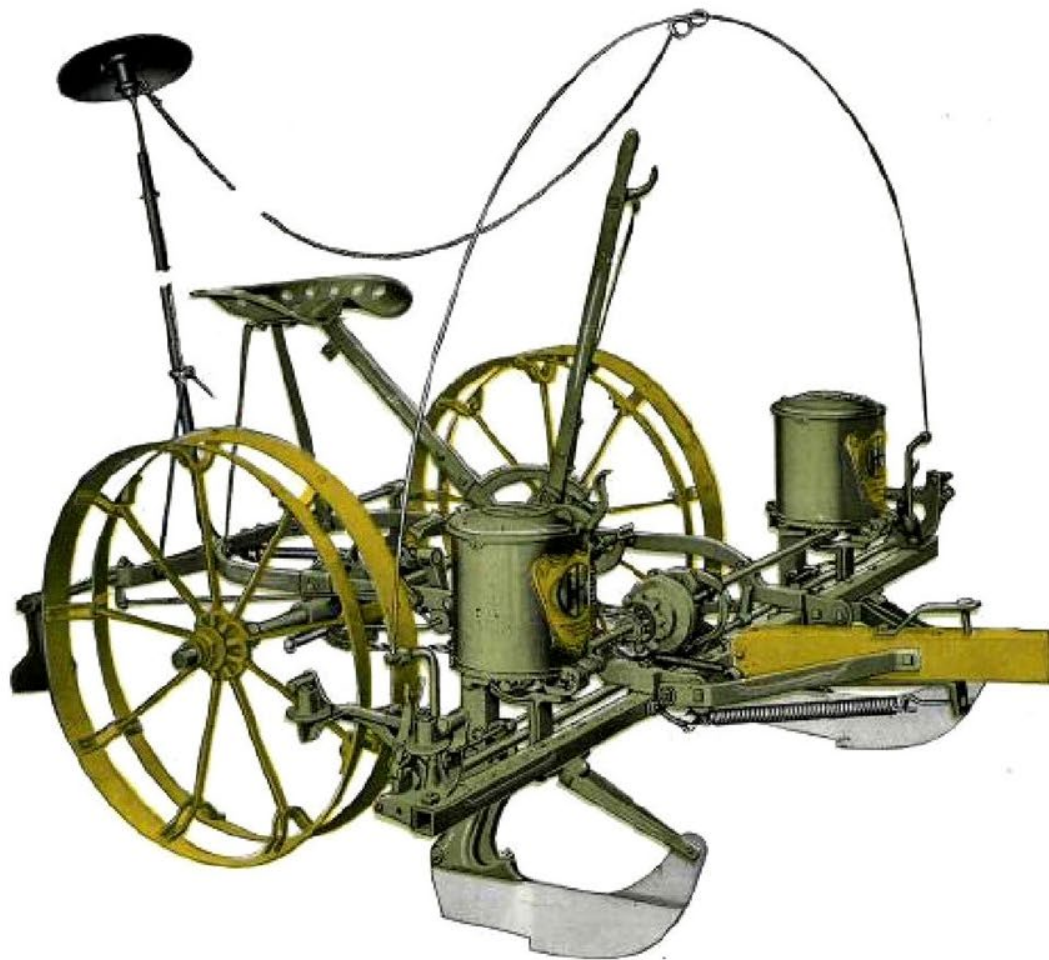
Illust. 1A—Chattanooga No. 95 chilled walking plow, with jointer and gauge wheel.



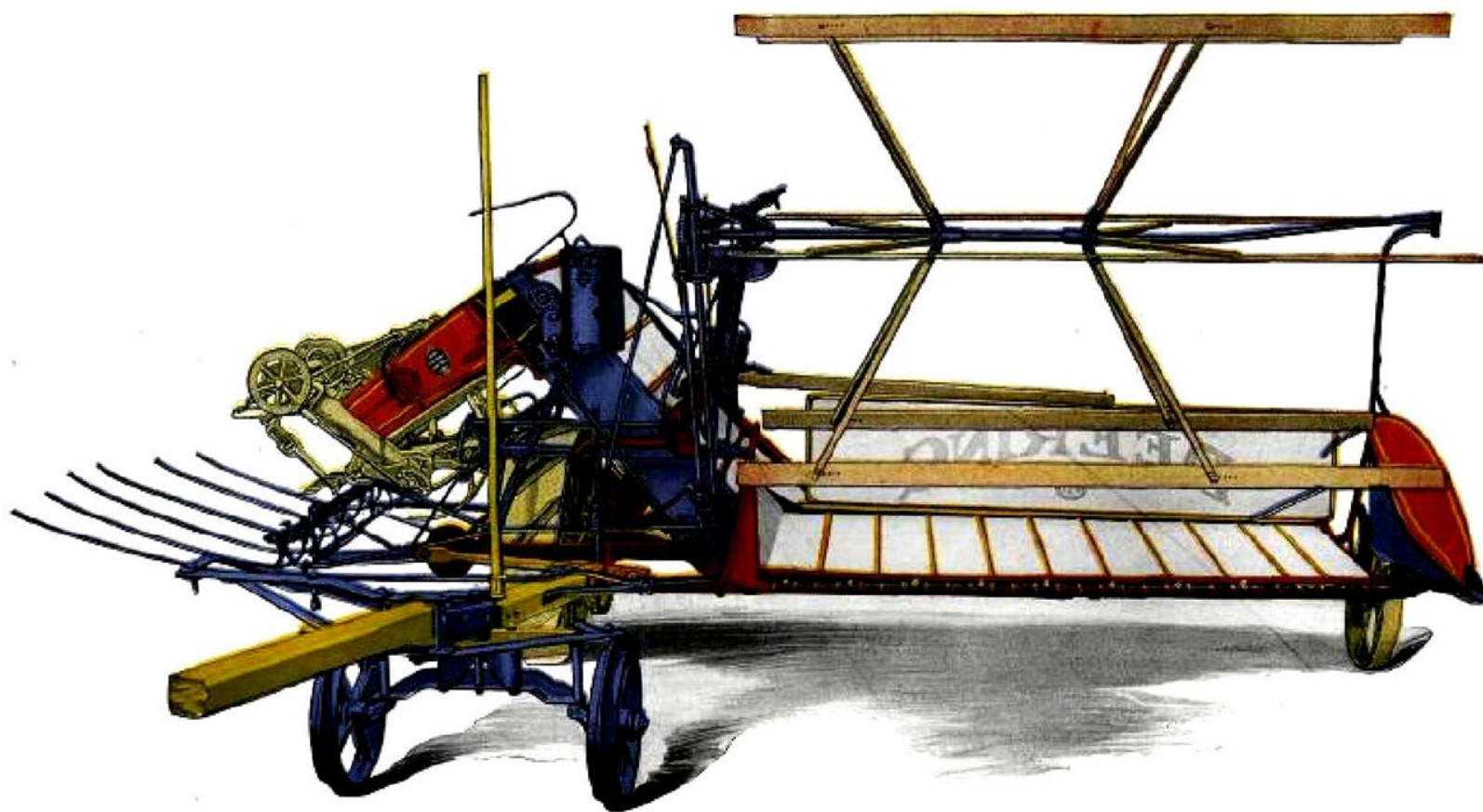
Illust. 15—P & O No. 2 Diamond gang plow.



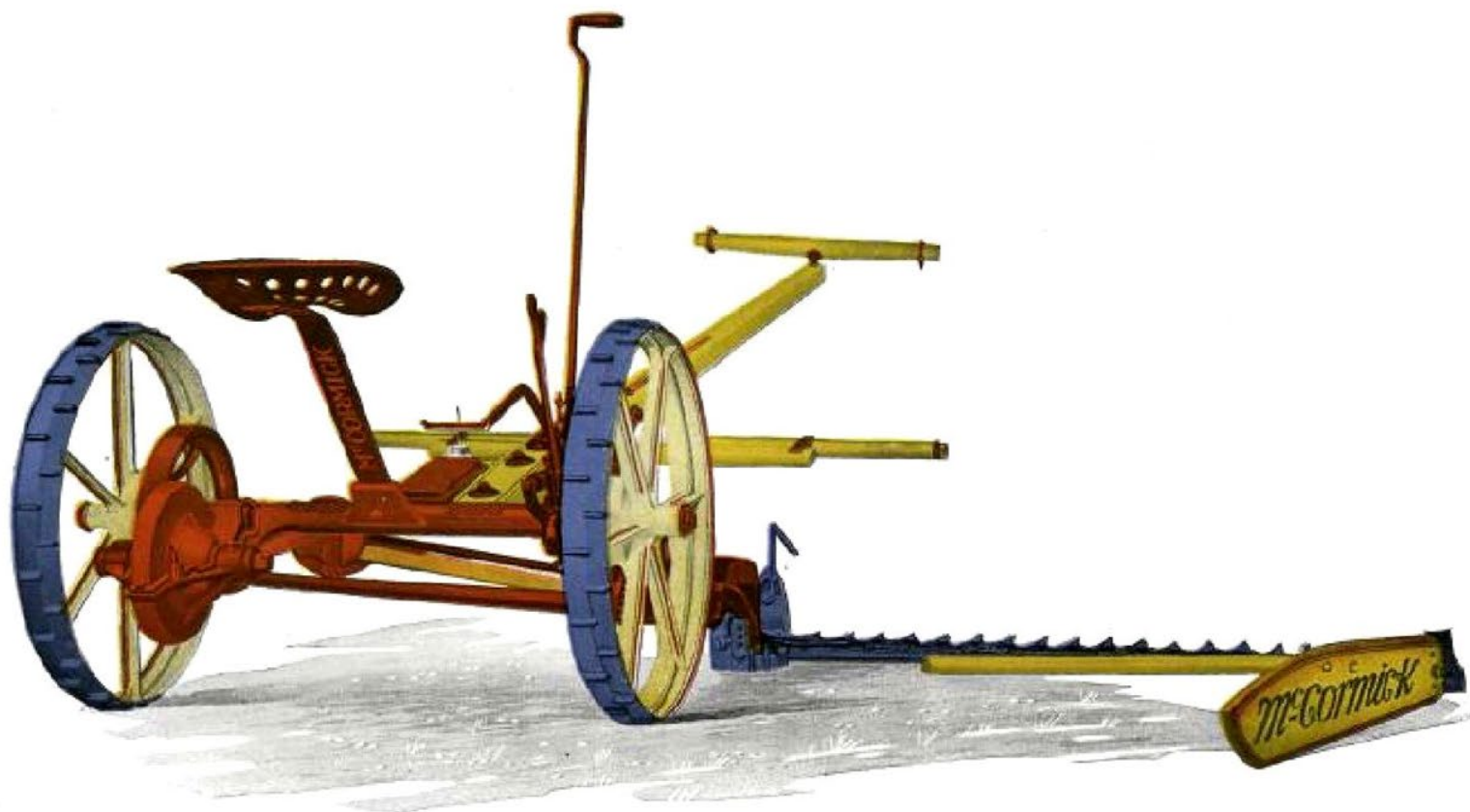
Illust. 1—McCormick corn binders are popular in all corn-growing sections. They save labor and time in harvesting the corn crop.



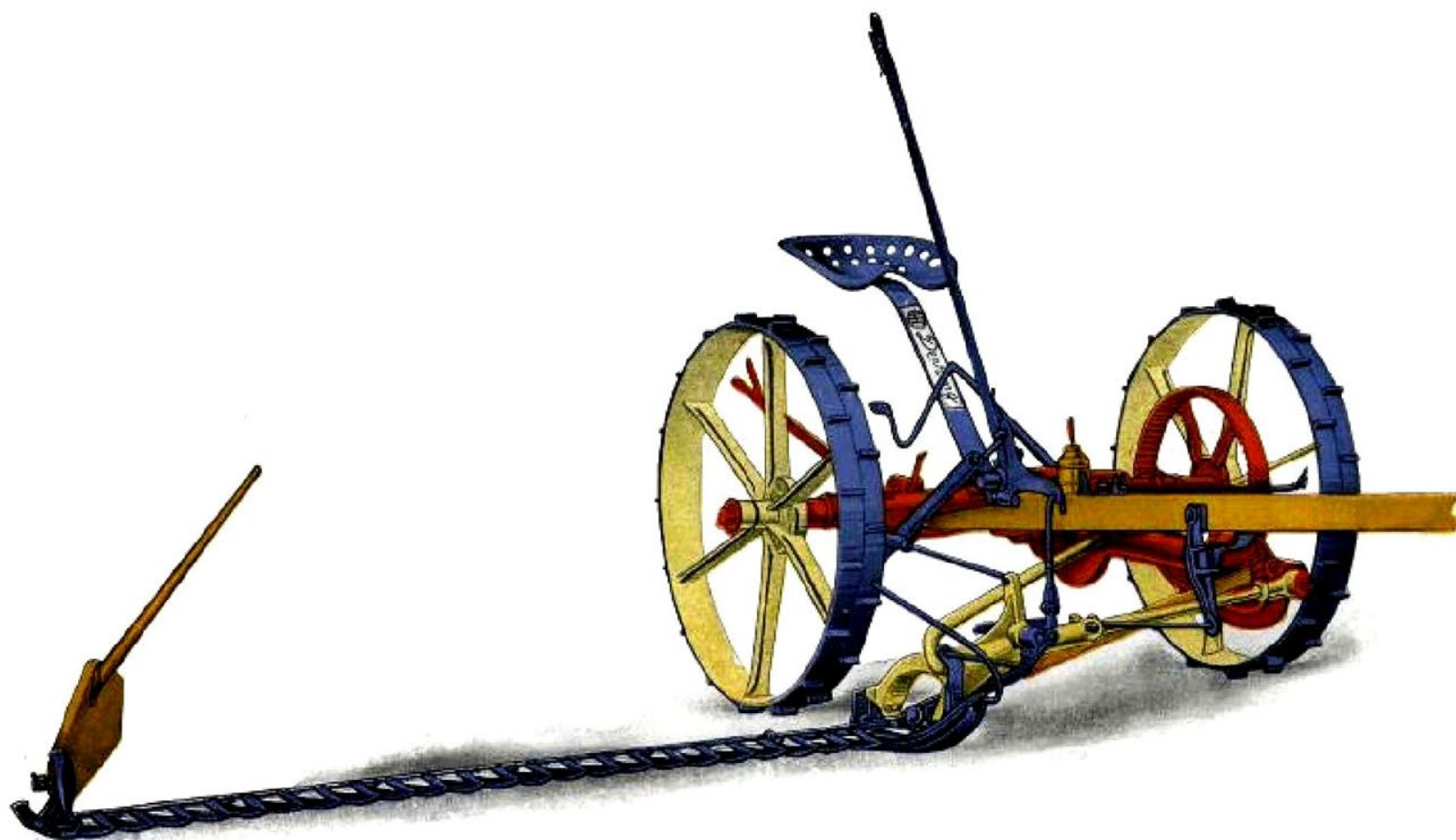
Illust. 1—International No. 1 corn planter. This is the favorite planter throughout the corn belt.
